The Jackson, Memphis and Nashville Chapters of NAREB recently held a commemorative "A Seat at the Table" celebration for the 2024 incoming President of the Tennessee Realtors, Mrs. Regina Hubbard. It is noteworthy that Mrs. Hubbard is the first African American female realtor to hold this position in the history of TR and currently serves as the only African American of the Executive Board of the almost 100 year old organization. As a 27 year veteran of the real estate industry, Mrs. Hubbard brings a very impressive resume to TR to fulfill their vision and mission through application of it strategic core pillars to, I. Elevate II. Advocate III. Promote and IV. Engage its membership for success.

Mrs Regina Hubbard is the widow of a realtor, Mr. Lester Hubbard, whom she followed into the real estate profession. Together they were the broker owners of Lester Hubbard Realtors for over 17 years. Her history in the real estate industry has always been one of participation, learning, growth and inclusion. President Hubbard is a graduate of Case Western University, a Leadership Memphis Grassroots graduate, Leadership Tennessee Realtors graduate, former GRI Student of the Year, and a broker/trainer with Fast Track Realty. President Hubbard holds the ABR, E-PRO, Master GRI, At Home with Diversity, CIPS designations and C2EX Endorsement. In 2022 Regina Hubbard was selected as NAR's first ever C2EX (Commitment to Excellence) Ambassador of the year. In addition to being a 23-year member of Memphis Area Association of Realtors, Mrs. Hubbard is a past President, Director and Officer of MAAR; a NAREB Realist of the Year, a member, former Director and Officer; a community volunteer with Habitat for Humanity and other affordable housing platforms including board membership with THDA, and Convergence Memphis. President Hubbard's tireless participation for Equity in Housing and her motto, a paraphrase of the Golden Rule: "Treat each customer the way I want to be treated in the same situation" are great personal and professional pillars that we in the real estate finance industry and membership of TNMBA chapters across the state wish her much success as the 2024 President of Tennessee Realtors.

Building Black History ORANGE MOUND, TN



Orange Mound, a Memphis community created for African Americans in the late nineteenth century, is a significant example of how "Jim Crow" segregation impacted neighborhood development in urban Tennessee. In 1890, developer E. E. Meacham acquired a portion of the earlier Deaderick Plantation to construct a segregated neighborhood for African American homeowners. He named the neighborhood Orange Mound after the Osage Orange hedges that had lined the Deaderick Plantation. The new neighborhood bordered the Mid-South Fairgrounds to the southeast while a stronghold of the Ku Klux Klan bordered the fairgrounds just to the west.


